Located in OC Koreatown, the final phase of Garden Grove's largest residential and commercial mixed-use development is now under construction.

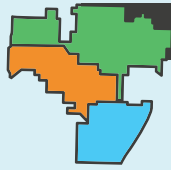

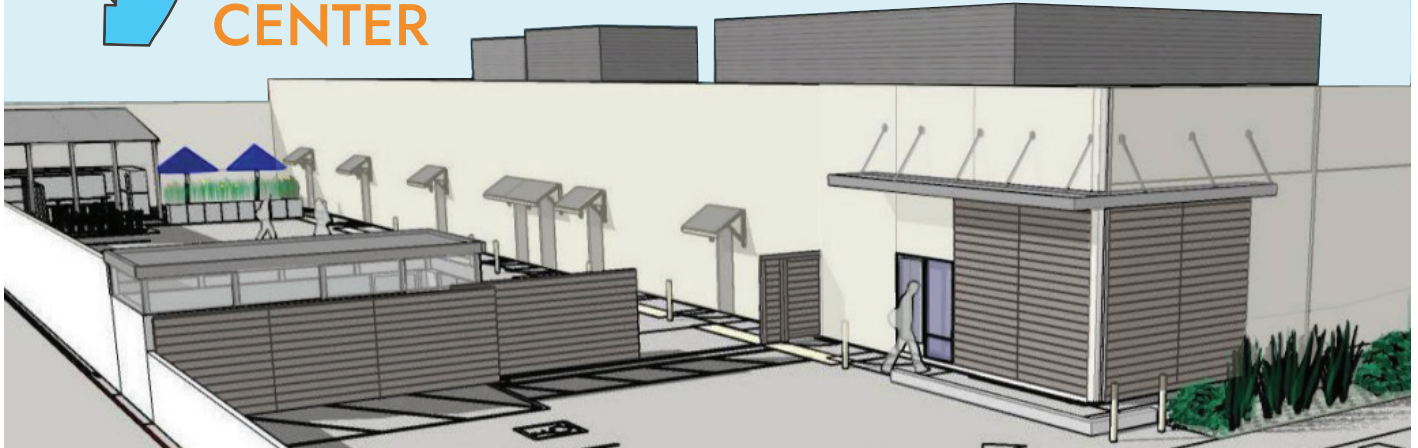

CENTRAL CITIES NAVIGATION CENTER



The City's first navigation center is currently under construction—one of the City's many collaborative efforts to create a solution to homelessness.

The Central Cities Navigation Center will be a referral-based, transitional facility that will offer emergency housing and wrap-around services to individuals experiencing homelessness from Garden Grove, Fountain Valley, and Westminster.

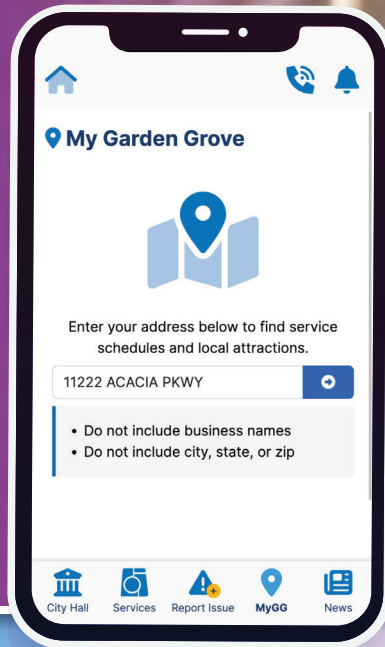

PUBLIC WORKS NEW EQUIPMENT

The Public Works Department recently obtained new operating equipment to perform a wide range of construction, maintenance, and repairs to Garden Grove streets.

Two asphalt pavers will address and rehabilitate the city's deteriorating alleyways in a timely manner that is safe and cost saving.

The skid steer with a sweeper attachment, an asphalt grinder, a concrete breaker, and a regular bucket will help perform yearly slurry projects.

GGADU

Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) are independent living units attached or detached to a single-family home. ADUs are innovative, affordable, and an effective option for adding much-needed housing in Garden Grove.

The City developed an ADU program to help residents, developers, contractors, and architects easily build ADUs in compliance with the City's ordinance.
